OSHA 10: This class will cover all safety issues required to obtain an OSHA 10 card. Mandatory attendance of all four classes is required to receive the OSHA 10 card. This course may be taken as an OSHA refresher for members.

GTAW: Includes the fundamentals and a lot of hands-on training and practice in Gas Tungsten Arc Welding (TIG). Materials welded will begin with carbon steel but will progress to Stainless Steel and Aluminum. The class will allow the participants to practice at their own pace, going through a series of exercises.

HOISTING AND RIGGING: This class will cover rigging fundamentals as they pertain to material lifts and proper crane signaling. Students will be given the opportunity to earn an OSHA 29CFR1926 Subpart CC at the completion of class.
