PLANS & SPECS: This course is designed to teach students how to use the plans and specifications and related documents for a construction project.

WELDING: This class will cover developing basic skills and proper techniques in both SMAW and GMAW welding disciplines for beginners and a chance to brush up skills for established welders, with a chance to certify if desired.

CPR: Members will receive a CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) certification upon completion of this class.

FIRST AID: This class will cover the First Aid as it relates to the construction industry.

BASIC SERVICE: This course is completely self-paced and online. Students must have access to a computer or iPad to perform tasks within the course. Students will utilize Interplay Learning to learn Basic Heating, Basic Cooling, and Basic Electricity. The course will take approximately 40hrs to complete the three disciplines. Students will have access to the assignments for three months.
