AUTOCAD: Learn the basic commands and fundamentals of AutoCAD. Progress of the class is subject to the ability of the students and will gear towards HVAC duct drawings. Basic computer skills are a requirement.

BEGINNER GTAW: This class will cover the basics of GTAW. Participants will be practicing a lot of hands-on exercises and procedures working towards certifications.

MATH: This class is designed for members who want to refresh their sheet metal math skills. Curriculum covered will be basic math, geometry, and trigonometry applicable to the sheet metal industry.
