PRE-APPRENTICE CLASS: This class is designed to give the Pre-Apprentice a better knowledge of the skills required to be a Sheet Metal Worker. Topics covered will be basic math/calculator skills, basic blueprint reading, as well as studying for the Work Keys Entrance Exam. Upon completion, the participants will receive 2 education points toward their ranking on the Apprentice Eligibility list. **Highly recommended for all Pre-Apprentices or anyone interested in becoming an Apprentice!**

GTAW FOR BEGINNERS: Includes the fundamentals and practice in Gas Tungsten Arc Welding (TIG). Materials welded will involve carbon steel. **This class will be for beginners. One night will be spent in the classroom. Certification WILL NOT be offered.**

FIRST AID/CPR: This class will cover the First Aid as it relates to the construction industry. Members will receive a CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) certification upon completion of this class.

ICA (Infection Control Awareness) : This course introduces the rationale for infection control assessments and plans in healthcare facilities during construction and renovation, conveys details regarding infection risks and mitigation, explains responsibilities for various parties, and outlines best practices for sheet metal workers to follow to ensure infection control and protection of patients, staff, and other workers. At the end of the class, members will take an exam to obtain a certification of completion from the ITI.
